# Point of Sale + EFPTOS

On Friday 26 May 2017 we implemented our new Point of Sale (POS) with EFTPOS that replaces the old Cash Register. This new technology improves customer service, introduces alternative payments (EFTPOS) as well as handling cash transactions while offering advanced stock management controls including state of the art reporting making Jim (Providore) and Brett's (Treasurer) functions extremely easy to monitor remotely.

So customers will now have the option to pay for purchases including Green Fees:

- by cash
- using EFTPOS
- running a tab
  - Bar staff will assist members wishing to set up a tab.
  - You will need to leave your credit/debit card at the bar.
  - You can nominate an indicative value which you plan to spend.
  - The tab will be settled when you leave the club.
  - Arrangements can be made to email a tax invoice/receipt once payment is completed.
  - Customers, of course, are only charged for amount they have used in purchases.

We would appreciate your patience and understanding with our amazing volunteer bar staff while transitioning into this new system.

It seems an appropriate opportunity to acknowledge the incredible work our bar staff volunteers perform for our club.

Maleny Primary School Sporting Schools program commenced as an after school activity (3pm to 4pm) on Tuesday 16 May 2017 with 34 students enrolling - the most participants for any sporting program previously offered.

Special thanks to PE Teacher Shane Turner and bowls coach MBC Chairman Graeme Glover for creating an interactive, challenging and exciting range of activities that has enthralled the children who are mesmerised with lawn bowls.

Thanks also to teacher Greg Corkin and MBC representatives Jim King and Brett Gillis in assisting in coordinating the activities which has a wonderful experience for all involved.

Enthusiasm has been riding high with the decision to conduct the remaining 4 weeks of the program at the Maleny Bowls Club with the children eager to experience the lawn bowls green environment for themselves.

Government funding provided through the scheme allowed the school to purchase 2 x Junior Jack Attack bowls kit (*valued at \$1,500*) to help introduce young children to the sport. Special thanks to the generosity of PE Teacher Shane Turner and the school who have offered for the kits to be stored and used by Maleny Bowls Club following the conclusion of the 6 week program which is sensational.
