Special General Meeting 24 October 2017 Membership Fees

This meeting was called to discuss changing the Membership fees to facilitate attracting more members into the Club.

A motion to change the Full membership to \$75.00 and Social membership to \$15.00 to begin the discussion was Moved by Joseph Walters, and Seconded by Jim King.

Correspondence from Kay Gesch confirmed her agreement to changing to this, and correspondence from Don and Margaret Ginns stated they did not agree to lower the Full membership fee. Copies available.

An amendment to the above motion to make Social membership remain at \$10.00, and Full Membership to be Full Capitation fees plus \$10.00. Dual membership will remain at \$45.00. was moved by Jim King and seconded by Brett Gillis.

A show of hands was called for, and the motion was passed unanimously. No one at the meeting was against.

Graeme opened the meeting and welcomed members.

Jim King outlined the background to the project, the scope of work and the details of the quotations received.

The financing of the project was proposed as follows:

Borrow		\$12,000
Cost of Project	<i>(includes \$2,000 contingency)</i>	\$65,000

It was advised that the work would take place in the new year and that Graeme would coordinate assisted by Ian Chatterton and David Burgess.

The following motion was put to the meeting:

Motion: That approval is given for the Maleny Bowls Club to expend up to \$65,000 for the purpose of refurbishment of the bar.

Motion was carried unanimously.

November 2017 Committee Meeting

Our monthly Board meeting was held on Monday 13th November 2017 with Graeme Glover, Jim King, Joe Walters, Dennis Kyling and Brett Gillis in attendance.

Items discussed and actioned include:

- Special General Meeting - Bar Extension Approval

There is a special general meeting Tues 14th November 2017 to approve an expenditure of up to 65k on the new bar. If this is approved, a motion was put that we only borrow 12k to put to the 28k and make up the 25k from our bank account. Put by Jim King, Seconded by Joe Walters, all in agreement.

Construction of the new bar will start in January if possible.

- Club Maintenance

Graeme advised that we would hold off the repairs/painting of the back wall for the present due to hot weather and also advised we had a big clean up of the sheds and offices.

- 2018 Annual General Meeting

The AGM for 2018 is to be held on Saturday March 3rd 2018.

- WorkPlace Health and Safety Issues

All documents are now available on Google Drive.

Incident report forms are to be available in the First Aid Kit.

Fire and Evacuation Plan is on the walls, and Dennis Kyling will be the person to report to for any issues.

The smoking plan need an updated diagram, Dennis Kyling to arrange for.

The builder for the bar renovations is to be made aware of our asbestos register and document his conformance to.

- 2018 Scroungers

The proposal from Miles Allan re the changes to Scroungers was approved and we will adopt same. It was noted that there is a chance to relook at this in 6 months. Miles offered to continue in this position with Doug McGufficke.

Commences back on Friday 5 January 2018 - 'friendly' games until the competition starts.

Competition no. 1 starts on 2 Feb, finishes 29 June (23 weeks).

Competition no. 2 starts on 13 July, finishes 7 Dec (22 weeks).

To qualify for each final, players have to play a minimum of 10 games.

Change Rule 1 and Rule 2 to read:

Any bowlers may play Scroungers. To play in the finals, a player must be a Social or Full member.

Change Rule 4 to read:

A final playoff will apply consisting of 18 ends - eg: top three players to play off for the trophy.

Change Rule 6 to read:

Scoring:

Closest to the jack – 3 points

Second closest – 2 points

Third closest – 1 point

Delete Rule 13. (It hasn't been followed for the last two years.)

Handicaps. The maximum handicap a player can get is +15 (currently +12).
