CHAIRMAN'S REPORT for AGM 2024

It is with great pleasure that I present the Chairman's Report for 2023. It has been an interesting year for the Maleny Bowls Club with the previous Chairman's resignation leading to a change of leadership with the Deputy Chairman moving to the role of Chairman.

The club is in a strong financial position as the Treasurer will document in the Treasurer's report. This is due to attendance at our club events being at 95 % pre-covid status, income from events such as; Tuesday weekly pairs, Wednesday Twilight Bowls, Friday scrounges with major days being our Plum Pudding Day and Closed Fours and our monthly Pairs, successful grants applications, and sponsorships from our local businesses to support competitions, weekly draws and our Junior Bowls Academy. We would like to thank the following sponsors for their ongoing support: Brouhaha, Judi Coey Optometry, IGA, Maleny Hotel, RSL, Maleny Quality Meats, Purple Palate, Audika and Les and Linda Fawkes.

Throughout the year the maintenance of the physical environment has continued to ensure the quality of our green and surrounds with the annual refurbishment of the green, installation of a cold-water bubbler, servicing of bar equipment and with the purchase of new crockery for our dining area. The club has also purchased 23 sets of junior bowls.

A major initiative that was implemented this year by the club's Games Director, was the revival, after a ten-year hiatus, of entering in the District Pennant Competition in Division Ten, which Maleny Club was successful in winning; as well as the organisation of our local club championships along with our weekly events. Another successful initiative for the club, is the Juniors Committee with a clear focus to attract junior members, whereby we now have 7 junior members with the prospect of more signings due to close affiliations and marketing with the local state primary and high school sports programs.

We would like to thank, Mr Andrew Powell MP for his continued support as patron of the club.

Maleny Club continues to have a strong community focus within the Maleny community. This can be seen through its involvement and support of worthwhile organisations such as the Rural Fire Brigade and SES by hosting functions for these groups to thank them for their work in the local community, as well as opening its doors to host a range of events such as Christmas parties, birthday and post wedding events. The success of these functions has only been possible by the tireless efforts of volunteers, however small or great and is greatly appreciated. We thank you! A special mention for the ladies who assist in the catering of our signature events in the club and our 'phantom' greens keeper "Les" who works tirelessly to ensure our well-manicured playing surface.

Finally, thank you to the board members, past and present, for their tireless efforts throughout the year and wishing the new board success for the coming year!

After 12 ends Dave was ahead 15 shots to Basil 2 shots.

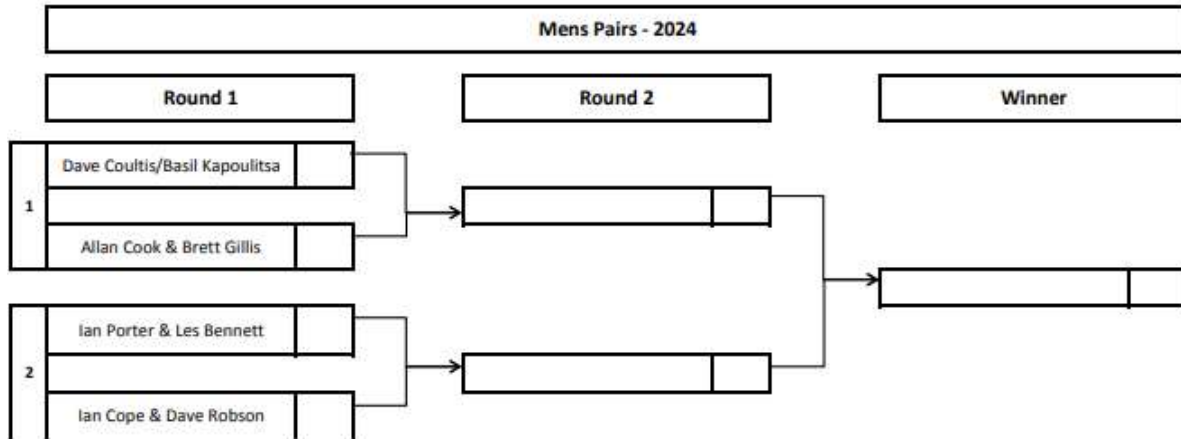
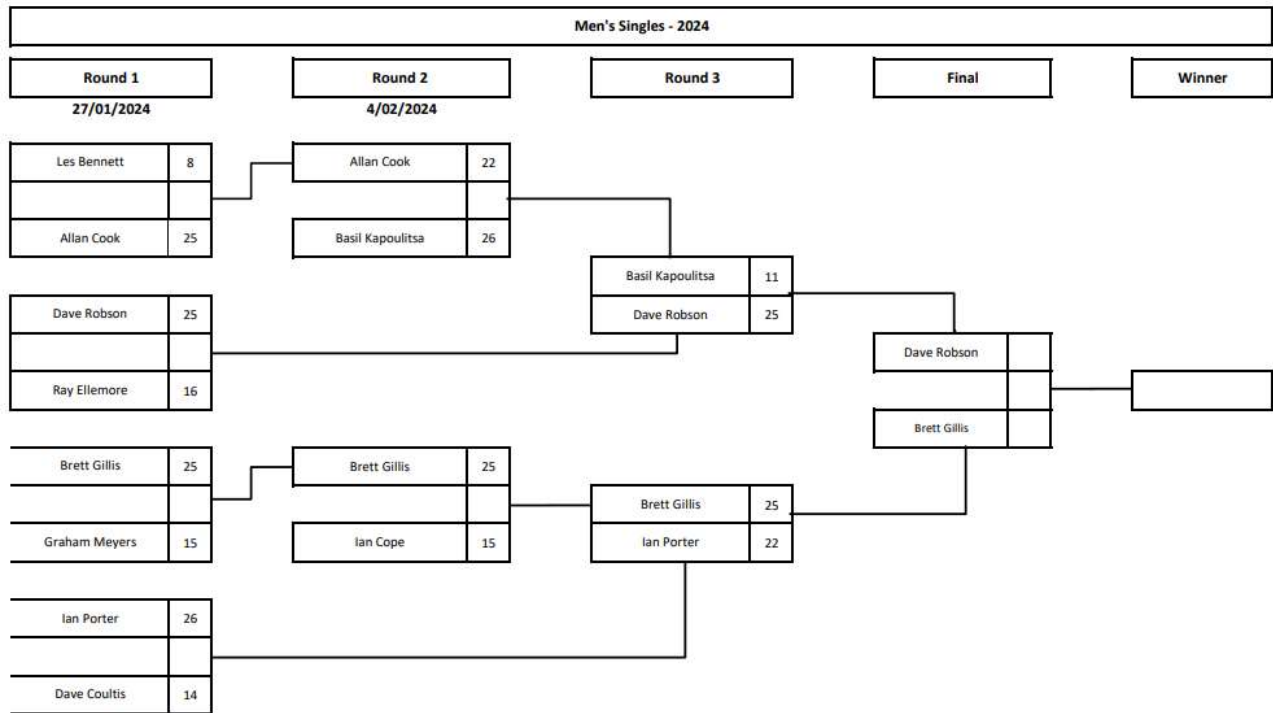

The first 5 weeks of our Friday Scroungers have seen some terrific bowls played with many close scoring matches.

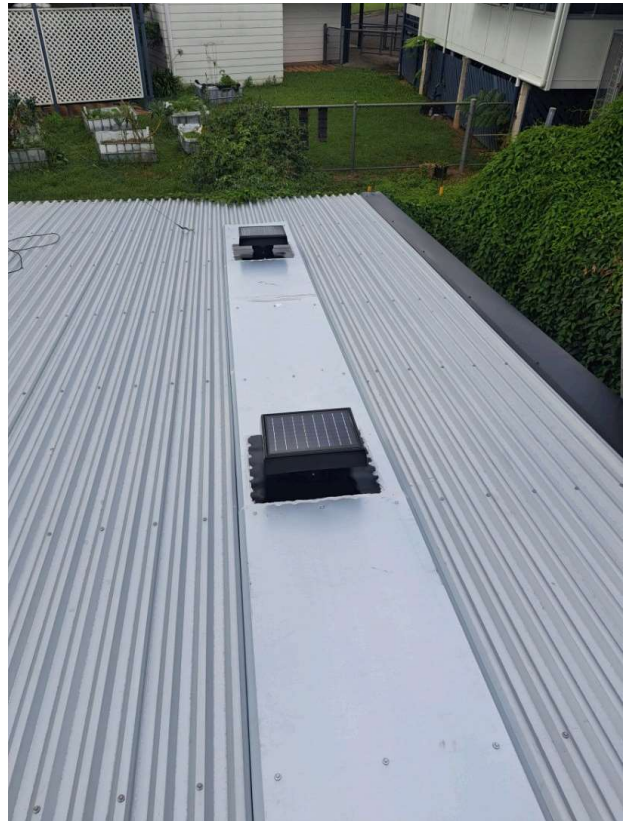
Dave Robson is the early leader with 3 wins closely followed by Brett Gillis, Ian Porter and John Reid all with 2 wins.

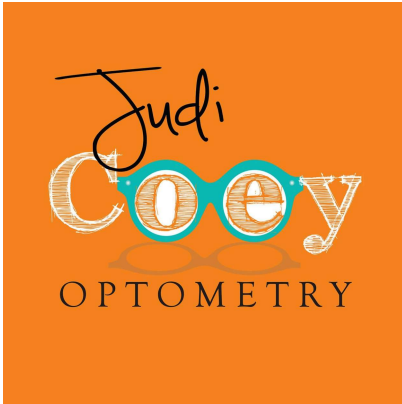
200mm Bradford solar exhaust , shaft and grill in ceiling to Cellar room.
